It's a smooth, rich wine with firm tannins that could stand up to pork roll stuffed with prunes. - M.L. (12/15/2010) - 92</p>

The wood is well-integrated, and the wine is juicy and firm on the palate. Drink after 2010. - M.L. (4/1/2008) - 91</p>

It is an inky and thickly concentrated wine with more sweetness on the palate in the form of blackberry jam and cinnamon. It has a chewy, chocolate fudge-like finish. - M.L. (11/1/2009) - 89</p>
